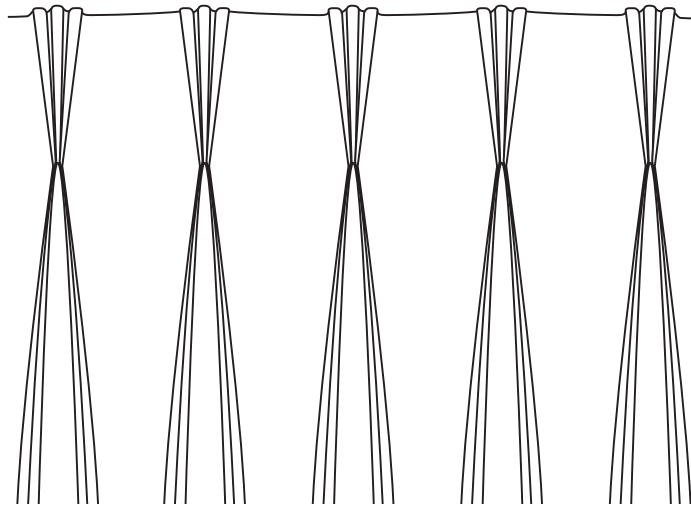


Pinch Pleat curtains



hanging your curtains

Pinch Pleat curtains are delivered ready to hang, complete with adjustable metal hooks.

The hooks can be moved to allow you to adjust the length of the curtain. To reposition the hooks, hold a tape measure against the heading to mark where the hook should be inserted. Gently ease the straight part of the hook through the fabric and buckram (stiffened lining) behind each pinch pleat and the flat piece of fabric at each end of the curtain. Take extra care not to go through to the front of the curtain.

dressing your curtains

To achieve a professional look when hanging curtains takes time but we assure you it is worth it!

First pull the curtains back, making sure the spaces between the curtain hooks are even and the fabric pulled forward. If hanging from a pole, the fabric between the curtain hooks can go back towards the window if you prefer this effect. Starting from the top, gently smooth each curtain into pleats. Then use strips of fabric to tie around the whole curtain and keep the pleats in place. Keep the curtains tied in position for as long as possible - we recommend at least 48 hours if you can. This will allow your curtains to develop distinct and even pleats.
